

## Declaration of Eligibility

Office use only

### This Statutory Declaration is to declare your eligibility to purchase a home through HomeSeeker SA.

An expression of interest in a property listed on the HomeSeeker SA website is subject to a completed, signed and witnessed copy of this Declaration declaring eligibility to buy through HomeSeeker SA. If this Declaration is not completed and returned to the Real Estate Agent within five business days, the opportunity to be first in line to purchase will be cancelled.

This Declaration is not a contract of sale document. Both the purchaser and vendor must sign a contract of sale before this Declaration becomes legally binding, and a Declaration may be withdrawn at any time before signing a contract of sale document. A person who intentionally makes a false statement in a statutory declaration is guilty of a criminal offence under the *Oaths Act 1936 (SA)*.

#### I/we declare that:

- All purchasers are aged 18 or over, and at least one applicant must be an Australian citizen or have permanent residency in Australia.
- Combined purchaser income is within the eligibility for HomeSeeker SA
  - Greater Adelaide: \$115,000 singles  
\$150,000 couples/families
  - Regional SA: \$90,000 singles  
\$115,000 couples/families.
- I/we do not own, or have a current and direct interest in, any residential property or land, including overseas or in regional Australia
  - EXCEPT WHERE
    - > there is a binding contract for the sale of a property.
- Combined purchaser non-housing assets are valued under the allowed limits
  - \$566,000 singles
  - \$722,000 couples/families.
- All purchasers intend to reside in the property being purchased through HomeSeeker SA at the address listed below

for a continuous period of no less than 6 months following property settlement.
- To the best of my/our knowledge and belief all the information contained on this declaration of eligibility is true and correct.
- I/we have disclosed all information requested to enable confirmation of eligibility for HomeSeeker SA.
- I/we consent to the Government of South Australia using third parties (Agent) to arrange for the completion of this form and the collection and delivery (email) of the information in this form to the HomeSeeker SA administrators.
- I/we make this solemn declaration, conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the *Oaths Act 1936*.
- I/we understand that it is a criminal offence to wilfully make a declaration knowing it to be untrue, and that imposition of a prison term of up to four years can result from conviction.
